FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"Come follow me; and I will make you fishers of men!"

~Jesus

When I was a junior in high school, I'll never forget, I was at my locker getting my books for my next class—and my best friend, Tony Ruffin, walked up to me and said, "Mike? Would you be interested in visiting my church on Sunday morning?" I responded, with no hesitation, "Sure! I'd love to visit your church on Sunday morning." And sure enough, I kept my promise, and I visited his church on the following Sunday morning. That one visit to his church transformed the trajectory of my life and my personal walk with Christ. Several years later, I

became a deacon in that same church. Six years after that I became an associate minister.

Then I went



on to enroll in seminary at Lincoln Christian University to earn a Master of Divinity. And as they say, the rest is history. I went on to become a pastor and an avid Bible reader and (with all humility) a Bible scholar. However, it all started with an invitation from a friend who I saw every day at school; from a friend with whom I ate (the not so

tasty) school lunch with, regularly, in the cafeteria; from a friend whose house I spent the night at almost every weekend.

Research has shown that people are more likely to visit a church if they are invited by a close friend or family member than by any other method. We are quickly approaching September—when people begin to return to church after Labor Day weekend. It is imperative that we realized that we are called upon to be good stewards not only of our time, our money, and our talent; but also, of the church that God has blessed us with.

I want to encourage all of you to become good stewards of God's church. There are four ways in which you can become a good steward. First, you can become a good steward by pledging a financial gift to the church weekly, bi-weekly, monthly, or even quarterly. The financial gifts that are given to church are used to support our local ministry; to support ministries in the Greater Rochester area; and, to support our denomination (the United Church of Christ). Second, you can become a good steward by volunteering. There are countless ways you can serve in the church; and there are countless committees that are looking for new innovative talent (i.e., the Board of Christian Education, the Board of

Christian Action, the Finance Committee, the Buildings and Grounds Committee, the Board of Religious Service, and so many others.). If you are interested, just call the church office and we will be able to direct you to the right committee. Finally, you can become a good steward by inviting your friends and family members to our services on Sunday mornings. This last area is one that I am going to recommit myself to doing in the upcoming year and beyond. I am going to commit myself to becoming a better steward by inviting people I meet out in the community and in the Greater Rochester area to our church, just like my friend Tony Ruffin did for me. You never know—inviting someone to church on Sunday morning could possibly transform the trajectory of their life and their personal relationship with Christ. So, if you have been wrestling with trying to find out what you can do for your church, you can start by simply extending an invitation to your friends and family.

In conclusion, keep in mind what Jesus said to Peter and Andrew as they were standing in their boats, fishing in the Sea of Galilee. Jesus said to them, "Come follow me; and I will make you fishers of men!"
