





This year's CROP walk is scheduled for Sunday, May 5, 2024 - beginning at 1:00 pm - with check-in beginning at 12:30 pm.

The 6.2-mile walk starts at the United Methodist Church on Amity Street and proceeds to Adams Basin on the Erie Canal path.

Those who do not wish to walk the 6.2 miles can opt for a one-mile trek. Markers along the path will tally the milestones.

After a CROP Hunger Walk ends, 25% of the funds raised is returned to the host community to support local hunger fighting efforts.


